

ISLPED 2025 Camera-Ready Paper Submission

Due by June 16th, 2025

All accepted papers require the explicit submission of a camera-ready version, even if you do not intend to make any changes to your original submission. You must also complete the IEEE Copyright form and add a corresponding Copyright notice to your paper and check for compliance with IEEE formatting guidelines using IEEE eXpress.

To complete this process, please read carefully and follow the instructions below:

1. Prepare Final Manuscript

Step 1: Use the IEEE paper template

Formatting checks are enforced in the submission phase for final manuscripts. Please allow extra time to fix any formatting errors and use PDF-eXpress to generate a compliant file.

- Prepare the IEEE double-column US letter style format using IEEE Conference Proceeding templates.
- For IEEEtran class in LaTeX, use the following as the first line in your LaTeX source file:
`\documentclass[10pt, conference]{IEEEtran}` or
`\documentclass[9pt, conference]{IEEEtran}`
- Note that with IEEE conferences, the author affiliation is listed under the author's name, unlike IEEE transactions.
- Do not modify the template, such as the font size, margins, and line spacing. Papers that do not adhere to the template may be returned to the author for correction.
- Do not add any page numbering, header or footer (other than the copyright info discussed below, if applicable).
- All accepted papers (regular papers and posters) should be full-length of up to 6 pages, excluding references. References may be included within the 6-page limit or on one additional page. Inclusion of any non-reference content on the reference page will result in desk rejection. The manuscript and reference page must be combined into a single PDF file.

Step 2: Add the copyright notice

You need to add a copyright notice at the bottom-left of the first page of your paper. The appropriate copyright clearance code notice depends on the affiliation of the authors as also

specified in the electronic Copyright transfer form (for more details, you can check the guidelines set forth in the Copyright Instructions for IEEE Conference Proceedings):

- For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is:

U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright

- For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is:

979-8-3315-2710-5/25/\$31.00 ©2025 Crown

- For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is:

979-8-3315-2710-5/25/\$31.00 ©2025 European Union

- For all other papers the copyright notice is:

979-8-3315-2710-5/25/\$31.00 ©2025 IEEE

Latex users can add and un-comment one of the following lines as appropriate just before `\begin{document}` for the copyright notice to show up in your PDF:

Microsoft Word users, should place the appropriate text in a textbox (no borders) at the bottom of the left column on the first page. An example Word 2007-2010 (.docx) document, showing also the location of the text box, can be found [HERE](#).

Step 3: Update manuscript

You may make final updates to your originally submitted manuscript, in particular for taking reviewer feedback into account. Major changes apart from those specifically addressing reviewer comments are not permitted.

- Manuscripts should not be significantly modified from the reviewed versions unless explicitly instructed by the Technical Program Committee.
- The author list must remain unchanged. Adding or removing authors, or reordering the author list, is not allowed. However, you may update the corresponding author designation.

2. Check Format Using IEEE PDF eXpress

Use IEEE PDF eXpress to check that your PDF file is Xplore-compliant. If not, you can also use PDF eXpress to convert your source files into an IEEE Xplore-compliant PDF file (e.g., for **LaTeX** users, create a zip file that includes dvi and your eps figure files all together, and then upload the zip file for the system to convert into a compliant PDF file; for **MS Word** users, upload the Word file and let it convert and return a compliant PDF file). Do NOT use “*Approve for collection*” in PDF eXpress Plus, if requested.

To use IEEE PDF eXpress to check compliance of your PDF:

- Go to [IEEE PDF eXpress](#) Website.
- Create an IEEE PDF eXpress account (use conference ID: 65674X)
- Use ‘new user’ if you have not used this site before.

Note that compliance with IEEE PDF eXpress is mandatory and must be checked prior to submission of your paper.

3. Submit the Electronic Copyright form

Log-in to the [SOFTCONF](#) system and proceed to the final submission page for your paper. Before submitting the paper, follow the steps below (as also indicated on the final paper submission page of the SOFTCONF system):

- Complete the web-based IEEE Copyright Transfer by clicking on the link ***“Please Click here to submit IEEE Copyright information”***.

- Fill in the electronic IEEE copyright form
- Download the PDF of the completed form
- Upload the PDF of the completed copyright form to SOFTCONF using the ***“Upload copyright file”*** link together with your paper (see next step)

4. Submit the Final (Camera-ready) Paper

Submit your final paper PDF (and the source code as ZIP file) through the SOFTCONF system together with the PDF of the completed copyright form. Please check that the copyright notice in your PDF (only first page) matches the copyright specified in the copyright form (based on author affiliations).

Alongside the camera-ready PDF's, authors are required to collect and submit the source files for each paper – all files which were used to create the final output (PDF), be they Microsoft Word, LaTeX, image files, etc. If there are Supplements and Auxiliary Materials, they should be provided in separate zips and labeled as such - aux.zip or suppl.zip.

5. Register for the Conference

Note that each paper requires one full registration at the conference in order to be published. **The registration website will be made live soon.** It is delayed due to VAT issues in Iceland. We will extend the early registration rate deadline to a later date accordingly. In the meantime, we encourage you to start arranging your travel and accommodation to avoid higher costs. **We apologize for the inconvenience.**

6. Present Your Paper

Presentation of the accepted papers/posters at the conference is mandatory. Papers that are not presented will be excluded from publication in IEEE Xplore.
